

NOTICE TO PARENTS

The No Child Left Behind act requires secondary schools to provide student names, addresses, and telephone numbers to both military recruiters and institutions of higher education upon request. Parents and legal guardians of students, however, have the right to request that the school not release such information without prior written parental consent.

The purpose of this notice is to inform you of the law and provide you the opportunity to request that information about your child not be released to either military recruiters or institutions of higher education. To prevent the release of information, you must inform us by filling out the form below. If you do not inform us otherwise, we will be required by federal law to disclose your child's name, address, and telephone number to military recruiters and institutions of higher education that request this information.
